- 5. PUBLIC APPEARANCES Bryan Rosenquist spoke stating he saw something on the agenda for federal funding. He asked how much gas did Yale use and how much was leached off? He stated he was a homeowner in town and asked if he would be paying someone else's bill for the next 30 years.

- a. Consideration, discussion and action on fiscal year 2020-2021 budget amendments. Ms. Couch reviewed the proposed budget amendments. Jason Brown made the motion to approve the fiscal year 2020-21 budget amendments as presented, Larry Brown seconded the motion which passed as follows; Yea: Strader, Adsit, Jason Brown, Rosenquist, Larry Brown. - b. Consideration and discussion on the proposed 2021-2022 fiscal year municipal budget. Mr. Kelly went over a list of projects that need to be scheduled including fencing at the water towers, the water loop for West View Heights Addition, lift station upgrade, electrical upgrade with grant funding. ASCR project should be relatively inexpensive, street overlay project with an option to extend the current loan.
- c. Consideration, discussion and action to direct staff to make an application for funding under the 2021 unregulated utility consumer act. — Mr. McMillian stated Governor Stitt recently signed legislation through the Oklahoma Housing Finance Authority, at this time there's not many specifics. Mr. McMillian recommended that the Board approve to direct staff to make this application, he stated there are 80-85 municipalities in the same spot we are with gas charges. Jason Brown made the motion to direct staff to make an application for funding in the amount of \$1,391,499 under the 2021 unregulated utility consumer act. Mike Strader seconded the motion which passed as follows: Yea: Strader, Adsit, Jason Brown, Larry Brown Abstain: Rosenguist.

7. MISCELLANEOUS

- a. Report from Engineer on status of pipeline project. Craig Brownlee reported stating that we are better off than we would have thought with all of the rain. He stated with the weather they are still making decent progress and the contractor has been good to work with. Tim is working on getting the CNG scheduled.
- **b.** Report from Lone Chimney Rep: July 5 is the date for the chloramine switch over to take place. LCWA will be going to a 24-hour operation so that test can be run hourly.
